The operation has been leased in its entirety to EGIS under a fixed, 9-year lease and its delivery is scheduled for the end of the first half of 2013.

The investment department of Jones Lang LaSalle completed the transaction. The Seller and the Purchaser took advice from TSD Notaires and OUDOT & Associés respectively.
