## CAISSE DES DÉPÔTS GROUP, ARPAVIE, CDC HABITAT AND ICADE BEGIN CONSTRUCTION ON THE FIRST MULTI-SERVICE ELDERLY CARE HUB IN THE PARIS REGION, IN VILLIERS-LE-BEL (VAL-D'OISE)

This hub was designed to accommodate, on a single site, elderly patients requiring care regardless of their profiles and medical needs, on a comprehensive and tailored basis. It will combine all the preventive and support solutions needed to ensure the well-being of seniors and their carers.

As an accommodation centre also providing a range of services, this hub will be at the forefront of innovation as regards:

- Architecture: three accommodation sections laid out in a U-shape, with common spaces wrapped around an inner courtyard that provides vast terraces and green spaces;
- Organisational structure and interpersonal relationships: help, care and support services provided to elderly patients as well as local professionals are brought together on the same site to help seniors remain in their homes, prevent the loss of independence and support carers;
- Technology: a wide range of elderly care services will be available (telemedicine services and teleconsultations for residents and carers, monitoring of fluid intake, connected laundry management system, etc.).



On Wednesday, September 2, **Eric Lombard**, CEO of Caisse des Dépôts, **Olivier Wignolle**, CEO of Icade, **André Yché**, Chairman of the Executive Board of CDC Habitat, and **Laure de la Bretèche**, Chairwoman of ARPAVIE, broke ground on the future Arpavie elderly care hub in Villiers-le-Bel, in the presence of **Brigitte Bourguignon**, Deputy Minister in charge of Senior Independence to the Minister of Solidarity and Health, **Sophie Errante**, MP for the Loire-Atlantique department and Chairwoman of the Supervisory Board of Caisse des Dépôts, **Martin Hirsch**, Head of the Greater Paris University Hospital (AP-HP), **Jean-Louis Marsac**, Mayor of Villiers-le-Bel, **Laetitia Boisseau**, Councillor from the Val-d'Oise Department Council in charge of the elderly, and Nicolas Péju, Deputy Head of the Regional Health Agency (ARS) for the Paris region.

On one single site covering 7,340 sq.m, the hub will feature:

- A nursing home totalling 110 beds fully available to social assistance recipients, including:
  - Two Special Care and Activity Units (*Pôles d'Activités et de Soins Adaptés*, PASA)
  - and one Enhanced Accommodation Unit (*Unité d'Hébergement Renforcée*, UHR) providing 14 beds dedicated to residents suffering from Alzheimer's or related diseases;

- **A Day Services Unit (*Accueil de Jour, AJ*) catering for 20 seniors residing in their homes. They can regularly come together in a place intended to help them maintain their mental and physical independence as long as possible.** This is achieved through social interactions, fun-filled, manual and sports activities aimed at fostering cognitive skills, breaking isolation and learning again how to live in society. **The unit will provide support and respite care services for the residents' relatives and carers (*Plateforme d'accompagnement et de répit, PFR*)** in order to assist them in performing their duties and prevent exhaustion that may arise from their daily responsibilities;
- **A Temporary Accommodation Unit (*Hébergement Temporaire, HT*)** able to cater for 20 seniors will also provide physical and emotional relief for both carers and the people they care for during short-term stays;
- **A multi-purpose home help and care service (SPASAD) including home nursing care (SSIAD) with the capacity to care for 50 people**, provided in partnership with the Léonie Chaptal Foundation. Thanks to its expertise and local presence in a dozen municipalities, the foundation will make it possible to offer complementary, well-coordinated, personalised home help, support and care to vulnerable people.

This project, which will create a place and offer support for the elderly and their carers, is run by:

- ARPAVIE: manager;
- CDC Habitat: investor and landlord;
- Icade Promotion: project owner.

This elderly care hub is scheduled for completion in H1 2022.
