ICADE OFFICIALLY OPENS THE CARAT BUILDING IN ISSY-LES-MOULINEAUX

Nicolas Joly, CEO of Icade, officially opened the CARAT residential building in Issy-les-Moulineaux in the presence of its mayor André Santini on Wednesday, September 20, 2023. Built on the site of the former STARK printing work, this 5,400-sq.m upscale building features 72 housing units, including 22 set aside for social housing.





A showcase for nature

With over 500 sq.m of in-ground gardens in addition to large and leafy balconies and terraces, nature has been reintroduced into an Issy-les-Moulineaux neighbourhood which used to be 100% developed.

The structure was also built using high-quality, sustainable materials, in particular KRION (a mixture of minerals and resins) and natural stone façades. This dual composition makes it extremely durable.

The project obtained NF Living Environment HQE certification and the E+C- label for the social housing units and NF Living Environment certification and the E+C- label for the rest. It is also part of Icade's "1 arbre 1 habitant" (one tree for every resident) initiative, under which the Company is committed to planting 2.5 trees for every home built.

Mixed-use and inclusive

The CARAT building includes 72 housing units, among which:

- 30 open-market sale units,
- 20 intermediate housing units subject to a split of ownership in favour of Segens and Tonus,

- 22 social housing units subject to a split of ownership in favour of Seine Ouest Habitat et Patrimoine (SOHP, a French social housing investor and developer) as usufructuary, and the Établissement public des fonds de prévoyance militaire et de l'aéronautique (EPFP, a public body under the authority of the French Ministry of Armed Forces) as bare owner.

The inclusiveness of the project enables Issy-les-Moulineaux to welcome residents from all walks of life, thus contributing to the city's diversity.

"CARAT is an exemplary project which meets many of our challenges such as promoting mixed uses and diversity in addition to having nature reclaim its rightful place. With six projects under construction, we are proud to be working alongside Issy-les-Moulineaux to build the city of tomorrow." Nicolas Joly, CEO of Icade.
