On December 13, 2022, Icade Promotion and SOGEPROM signed the off-plan sale of 13,200 sq.m of office and retail space in the heart of Lyon's Part-Dieu district to Union Investment (acting on behalf of UniInstitutional European Real Estate).



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Formerly an RTE regional headquarters, the building will undergo a major overhaul to the highest technical and environmental standards which will include a timber-framed extension.

Designed by architectural firm Hérault Arnod Architectures, the building will have a leasable floor area of close to 13,200 sq.m over eight floors.

This office project will also include:

- a ground floor with shops, a lobby and amenities (including a business centre with a co-working space);
- a 600-sq.m in-ground garden in a space currently used for underground parking;
- extensive outdoor spaces, including accessible rooftop green space, terraces on all floors and a private garden

A **model of low-carbon construction**, the project also illustrates the expertise of Icade Promotion and SOGEPROM in large-scale renovations and extensions. By building on the existing asset and extensively using renewable bio-based materials, the building will be able to cut its carbon footprint in half and comply with the EU Taxonomy. The project also aims to obtain the best environmental certifications and labels: BBCA with an Efficient rating, HQE with an Excellent rating, Ready to OZMOSE, Wired Score Silver.

The project is scheduled for completion in Q1 2025.
